## EMPLOYEE HEALTH DEPARTMENT NEW HIRE REQUIREMENTS

Congratulations on your employment at Penn State Hershey Medical Center. Per policy A-100 HAM you will be scheduled for an initial health screen appointment which must be completed within 10 days of your hire/new employee orientation. Scheduling will be done through your hiring manager. This is a mandatory appointment so it must be rescheduled if missed. Please provide your vaccination record to the employee health department prior to this appointment. If you are unable to provide written documentation of previous vaccinations prior to your appointment, you will be required to have a blood test/titer and potential vaccination which will be provided free of charge at your appointment.

## The following information is required:

Documentation of all tuberculosis (TB) tests within the past two years <b>OR</b> if you have a
history of a past positive skin test, most current chest x-ray report and/or documentation
of treatment course.
Documentation of two <i>Measles, Mumps, and Rubella</i> (MMR) vaccines <b>OR</b> written
documentation of blood test/titer for Measles (Rubeola), Mumps, AND German
Measles (Rubella).
Documentation of two Varicella (Chicken Pox) Vaccines OR written documentation of
blood test/titer for Varicella (VZVG/Chicken Pox).
Documentation of the <i>Hepatitis B</i> vaccination series and antibody testing. Hepatitis B
vaccination is strongly recommended to employees who are potentially exposed to
blood/body fluids.
Documentation of Adult <i>Tetanus, Diptheria, Pertussis</i> (Tdap) Vaccine.
Documentation of your seasonal <i>Influenza</i> Vaccine. There is an expectation that
employees will receive Influenza Vaccine (offered yearly free of charge) for self, patient,
family, co-worker protection.

## **How to Locate Immunization (Vaccine) Records**

- Ask parents or other caregivers if they have records of your childhood immunizations
- Try looking through baby books or other saved documents from your childhood
- Check with your high school and/or college health services
- Check with previous employers (including the military) that may have required immunizations.
- Obtain through an employee health portal (You may be required to access portal if no letterhead)
- Check with your doctor or public health clinic
- Employee Health does not have access to Penn State Hershey Medical records.
